### Reopen Local 771

#### **If you are sick, stay home.**

Our top priority continues to be the health, safety and well-being of the community, our Members and our employees.

We are asking Members to continue paying dues online or via phone whenever possible.

On Monday June 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2020 the Hall will be open to our members to come in pay dues and purchase swag. The doors will remain locked. We ask that you remain in your parked car and call 306-522-7932 when you arrive. You will be let into the reception area once the previous member leaves. You will be required to use the provided hand sanitizer prior to entry. Due to the limited space at the front counter, we will only be permitting one member at a time to enter the Hall to access the front counter. We asked that you kindly come in alone as there is not enough room at the counter for more than 1 person to maintain the 2 meters required for physical distancing. The front desk has had a plexiglass barrier installed, please remain behind it while making your transaction. Should you require to meet with a staff member or Officer of the Local, please call and make an appointment prior to coming to the Hall. The washrooms will not be available to the public.

Those requiring training need to contact the training department, you will be required to fill out a screening questionnaire. We will have the meeting room set up for training and to maintain 2 meters between trainees. Those attending training will be limited to the shop and meeting room and use the shop door to access the Hall. Prior to accessing the Hall, you will be required to sanitize your hands with the supplied hand sanitizer stations. The offices will be off limits to Members. CWB testing will be by appointment only, booth space is limited and those who have expired tickets will take priority. CWB has extended the expiry dates on tickets, therefor retests will follow. All surfaces used during training or testing will be sanitized between groups. The first welding test is scheduled for Friday July 10<sup>th</sup>, 2020

We remind all Members and staff to practice the following:

- Wash hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds.
- Use hand sanitizer when hands are not visibly dirty and handwashing isn't available.
- Avoid touching your face, mouth, nose and eyes.
- Cough or sneeze into a tissue, then immediately dispose of the tissue and wash hands. If a tissue is not available, cough or sneeze into your elbow, not your hands.

**Those who do not follow the above requirements, will be asked to leave immediately.**
